

# A FEW QUESTIONS ANSWERED

## *Will Recreation Express run on MAC?*

Yes & No. As this is a Windows OS (Operating System) program, you cannot install it straight, just like a MAC program cannot be installed on Windows in the straight sense... however, As is required by MAC users for a variety of “Windows only” software, MAC users can install software such as “Parallels” ( <http://www.parallels.com/> ) and can run Windows software in the MAC environment. ## *Will Recreation Express work on Windows Vista?*

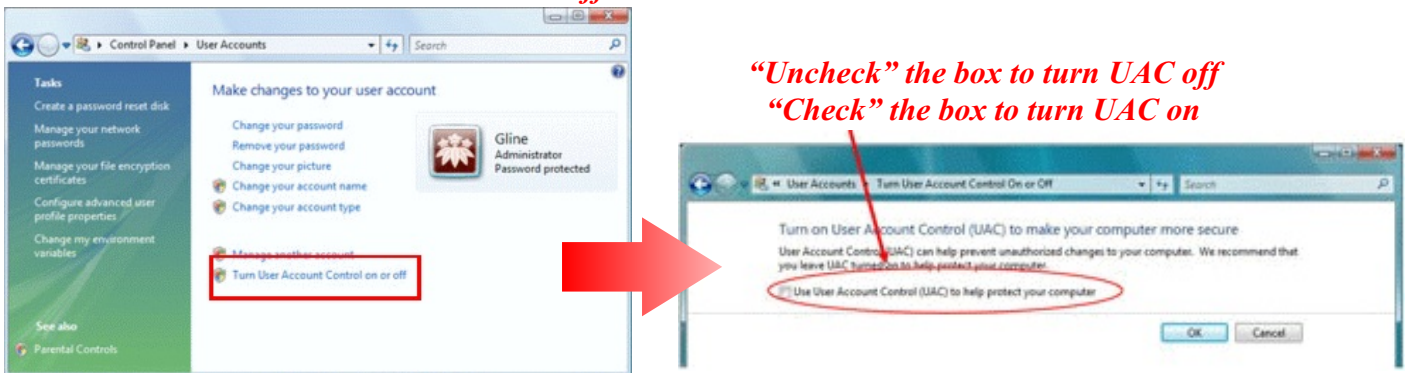
Yes RE2.0 is a Vista compatible program, however during installation you must be logged in as an administrator and have the UAC (User Account Control) turned off. It is important to remember that the UAC is a security feature that helps you decide whether a program can install or run (makes you aware that something is happening and allowing you to give permission). Recreation Express is a safe program. If you run the installation without turning off the UAC you will receive an error on the program’s first run.

## **To turn off the UAC:**

A. Be logged in with “Administrator” privileges

B. →  Start, →Control Panel, →Open “User Accounts”

## *Select “Turn User Account Control on or off”*



C. Turning off the UAC will require a computer restart. After the computer reboots, install Recreation Express.

**D. IT IS HIGHLY ADVISABLE TO TURN THE UAC BACK ON AFTER INSTALLATION!** Repeat the process as stated in “B.” Recreation Express will run normally each time with the UAC on.
